OF A
STATE OF EMERGENCY

I, EDMUND G. BROW. JR., Governor of the State of California, having found that conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property exist within the Counties of Los Angeles, Ventura, Orange, Riverside, San Bernardino, Santa Barbara, Kern and Tulare, State of California, beginning on February 5, 1978, as a result of heavy rains, winds, mudslides, flooding and heavy snow, and other conditions which, by reason of their magnitude, are beyond the control of the services, personnel, equipment and facilities of said Counties, and having been requested by the Chairmen of the Boards of Supervisors I proclaim a State of Emergency in the Counties of Los Angeles, Ventura, Orange, Riverside, San Bernardino, Santa Barbara, Kern and Tulare.

I DIRECT that as soon hereafter as possible this proclamation be filed in the Office of the Secretary of State and that widespread publicity and notice be given to this proclamation.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of California to be affixed.
