PROCLAMATION
OF A
STATE OF EMERGENCY

Executive Department
State of California

I, EDMUND G. BROWN JR., Governor of the State of California, having found that conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property exist within the County of Santa Barbara, beginning on August 13, 1978, as a result of an earthquake which, by reason of its magnitude, are beyond the control of the services, personnel, equipment, and facilities of said County, and having been requested by the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Barbara to proclaim a State of Emergency in said County, I therefore proclaim the existence of a State of Emergency in the County of Santa Barbara; and

I DIRECT that as soon hereafter as possible this proclamation be filed in the office of the Secretary of State and that widespread publicity and notice be given to this proclamation.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of California to be affixed.
