PROCLAMATION Deputy

STATE OF EMERGENCY

I, EDMUND G. BROWN JR., Governor of the State of California, having found that conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property caused by torrential storms resulting in severe flooding, mudslides and other conditions commencing on or about January 8, 1980, and continuing to present, which by reason of their magnitude are beyond the control of the services, personnel, equipment and facilities of affected Counties, and having been requested by the Chairpersons of the Boards of Supervisors, I proclaim a State of Emergency to exist in the Counties of:

I DIRECT Order #1 of the "Orders and Regulations Which May Be Promulgated by the Governor During a State of Emergency" and which were filed with the Secretary of State on the 24th day of January 1980 be invoked.

I FURTHER DIRECT that as soon hereafter as possible this proclamation be filed in the Office of the Secretary of State and that widespread publicity and notice be given to this proclamation.
