EXECUTIVE ORDER B. 95-82

WHEREAS, California has led the way in encouraging citizen participation in state government; and,

WHEREAS, California has successfully removed artificial barriers which have traditionally separated the private sector from the public sector; and,

WHEREAS, the use of private sector skills in the governmental process will serve to improve government effectiveness and establish a better basis for future understanding, communication, and cooperation among public and private sector individuals; and,

WHEREAS, only through coordinated action between business and government will there be enough talent and imagination to meet future challenges;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Edmund G. Brown Jr., Governor of the State of California, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by the Constitution and statutes of the State of California, do hereby issue this order to become effective immediately:

1. The Governor's Executive Fellows Program is hereby established under the co-sponsorship of the Governor's Office and the Business, Transportation and Housing Agency.
2. The purpose of the program is to provide highly talented business executives with experience in the operation of state government, and to provide state government with a better understanding of business.
3. The Governor will appoint a director of the program to operate from within the Governor's Office, with resources co-sponsored by the Governor's Office and the Business, Transportation and Housing Agency.
4. The director's duties will be to annually: identify significant state assignments for Executive Fellows; recruit and place Executive Fellows in those assignments; design a meaningful educational component to expose Executive Fellows to the operation of all branches of state government; and oversee the smooth operation of the program.
5. Executive Fellows will be selected from applicants in private businesses, corporations, and educational institutions, and will serve in their assignments at no expense to the state other than reimbursement


for certain travel expenses. Executive Fellows shall not be placed in any civil service position nor shall they displace any state employee.

6. At the completion of the tenure of each class of Executive Fellows, a report to the Governor will be made outlining the achievements, problems encountered, cost-benefit analysis, and recommendations for future enhancement and continuation of the program.
7. All state agencies, departments and commissions are hereby directed to assist and cooperate with the director of the program in opening the doors of government to the Executive Fellows, and to actively encourage this partnership.
