MEDITERRANEAN FRUIT FLY
EMERGENCY PROCLAMATION ORDER NO. 1

This Order is based on the Proclamation of a State of Emergency dated December 24, 1980 concerning the infestation of the Mediterranean fruit fly in the counties of Alameda and Santa Clara, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof, and subsection (d) of section 8646 of the Government Code.

The Director of Food and Agriculture is hereby authorized to enter into leases, contracts and agreements with private parties and government agencies for producing in Hawaii sterile Mediterranean fruit flies without complying with provisions of the State Contract Act, Government Code section 14250 et seq., and any other related statutory requirements which might otherwise be required. The Director shall maintain timely and accurate records of each such lease, contract or agreement for review by the Departments of Finance and General Services.
