EXECUTIVE ORDER B 12-75

WHEREAS, Article 7 (commencing with Section 21400) was added to Chapter 9 of Part 3 of Division 5 of Title 2 of the Government Code by Senate Bill No. 1764 (Statutes of 1974, Chapter 374) to provide group term life insurance benefits for prescribed full-time state or university employees;

WHEREAS, Section 21406 of the Government Code provides that the effective period of such insurance shall be the 1974-75 fiscal year. That section further provides that the effective period of insurance may be extended annually thereafter to the succeeding fiscal year by order of the Governor promulgated prior to January 1 of the preceding fiscal year.


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Edmund G. Brown Jr., Governor of the State of California, pursuant to the authority vested in me by Section 21406 of the Government Code hereby extend the effective period of the group term life insurance benefits to the 1976-77 fiscal year.
