PROCLAMATION

I, EDMUND G. BROWN JR., Governor of the State of California, having found that conditions of extreme peril no longer exist which threaten the safety of persons and property; and further finding that local authorities are now able to cope with the situation; therefore proclaim that the state of emergency previously proclaimed on the following dates and in the following jurisdictions no longer exists, effective immediately:

- November 24, 1975: County of Los Angeles;
- September 13, 1976: Counties of Imperial and Riverside;
- September 22, 1976: Counties of San Bernardino and San Diego.
