EXECUTIVE ORDER B-56-79

WHEREAS, Chapter 1252 of the Statutes of 1977 provides that effective July 1, 1979 the Department of Corrections and Department of Youth Authority are no longer located within the Health and Welfare Agency; and

WHEREAS, a reorganization plan for administrative placement of these departments is not completed;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Edmund G. Brown Jr., Governor of the State of California, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by the Constitution and statutes of the State of California, do hereby issue this order to become effective immediately:

Until such time as a reorganization plan regarding administrative location of the Departments of Corrections and the Youth Authority is duly adopted, said departments shall, on an interim basis, continue to report to the Governor through the Secretary of the Health and Welfare Agency.
