PROCLAMATION

I, EDMUND G. BROWN JR., Governor of the State of California, having proclaimed that conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property prevailed in that portion of San Bernardino County as described in my proclamation of a State of Emergency signed on the 8th day of May, 1979, do now find, at the request of the Board of Supervisors, it is necessary to amend the May 8, 1979 proclamation of a State of Emergency to exclude that portion of the County of San Bernardino generally known as the Big Bear area where the State of Emergency no longer exists.

The new description of that area of San Bernardino County where conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property yet prevail is that portion of the County of San Bernardino bounded on the north and east by a line beginning at the intersection of the boundary line between San Bernardino and Los Angeles Counties and the north line of Township 3 North, Range 7 West, SBB & M; thence east along the northern boundary of the San Bernardino National Forest to the range line between Ranges 1 and 2 West; thence south to the township line between Townships 1 and 2 North; thence east to the San Bernardino National Forest boundary; thence southerly and westerly along the San Bernardino National Forest boundary line to the intersection of the San Bernardino-Riverside County line.

Also to be excluded is a corridor of land consisting of that portion of Interstate Highways I-15E and I-15 and land lying within one-half mile of either side thereof beginning at a point on I-15E one-half mile southeasterly of the intersection of I-15E and Main Street, Devore, thence generally in a northerly direction following I-15E and I-15 to the north boundary of the San Bernardino National Forest.

Now, therefore, I proclaim that a State of Emergency no longer exists, effective immediately, in the area generally known as the Big Bear area and in the corridor described above, and therefore the regulations for California's Gasoline Emergency filed with the Secretary of State on May 23, 1979, are no longer effective in these excluded areas.
