Because of the eminent threat of danger to life and property in the Lake Elsinore area due to flood waters, I recommend that the Governor sign the emergency order waiving application of statutes dealing with payment bonds for public works, bidding of public works contracts, prevailing wages, and the State Contract Act.

EXECUTIVE EMERGENCY ORDER

I, Edmund G. Brown Jr., Governor of the State of California, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by the Constitution and statutes of this State, do hereby find and declare, pursuant to Government Code Section 8625, that, as a result of extreme precipitation commencing on or about January 8, 1980, causing severe flooding and endangering life and property, there exists a state of emergency, as specified in Government Code Section 8558(b), in that area of Riverside County threatened by the rising level of Lake Elsinore and affiliated rivers and streams (hereinafter the Lake Elsinore region);

In accordance with the California Emergency Services Act, and more specifically Government Code Section 8571, I hereby determine and declare that strict compliance with certain State statutes prescribing the procedure for conduct of State business would hinder and delay mitigation of the effects of said emergency;

NOW, THEREFORE, I hereby suspend application of the following statutes to the relocation of mobile homes, recreational vehicles and travel trailers from the Lake Elsinore region and activities related thereto:

1. All portions of the State Contract Act, Government Code Section 14250 et seq.;
2. All portions of Chapter 7 (commencing with Section 3247) of Title 15 of Part 4 of Division 3 of the Civil Code;
3. All provisions contained in Article 2 (commencing with Section 1770) of Chapter 1 of Part 7 of Division 2 of the Labor Code; and
4. Government Code Section 14780.

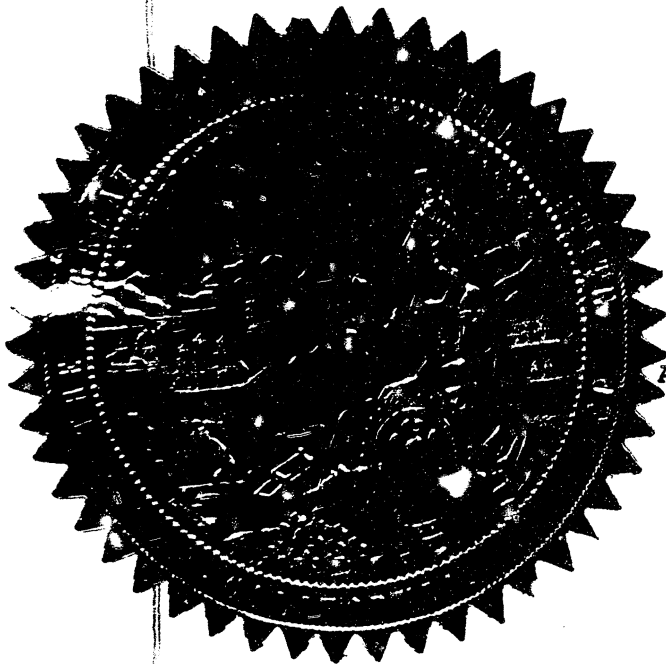
I HEREBY DIRECT that as soon hereafter as possible, this
