WHEREAS, during the month of November, 1965, abnormally heavy and continuous rainfall occurred throughout the southern portion of the State of California, and as a result of conditions created thereby on the 15th day of December, 1965, Glenn M. Anderson, Acting Governor of the State of California, proclaimed an emergency to exist throughout the Counties of Riverside, San Bernardino and Ventura; and

WHEREAS, during the month of December, 1965, abnormally heavy and continuous rainfall again occurred throughout the southern portion of the State of California, and as a result of conditions created thereby on the 19th day of January, 1966, I, Edmund G. Brown, Governor of the State of California, proclaimed an emergency to exist throughout the Counties of Los Angeles and San Diego; and

WHEREAS, the conditions resulting in the Proclamation of an Emergency, dated the 15th day of January, 1966, affected the entire southern portion of the State of California, including the Counties of Riverside, San Bernardino and Ventura, as to which the Proclamation of Emergency, dated the 15th day of December 1965, had been issued and

WHEREAS, the Counties of Riverside, San Bernardino and Ventura thereby suffered further serious damage to their road systems as did the State Highway System, which includes the Federal-aid, interstate, and primary, and portions of the

Federal-aid secondary systems, all of which constitute as of said date and continues to constitute an emergency affecting the entire State of California; and


WHEREAS, such conditions constitute an emergency as contemplated by the terms of Section 125 of Title 23 U. S. Code, as amended, and by Section 188.1 of the Streets and Highways Code;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Edmund G. Brown, Governor of the State of California, do hereby proclaim that the Proclamation of an Emergency issued on the 19th day of January, 1966, is hereby amended to include the Counties of Riverside, San Bernardino and Ventura and the Secretary of Commerce of the United States is hereby requested to concur in this Amendment to the said declaration of an emergency.
