EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. B 3-75

By the powers vested in me as governor, I hereby direct the Department of Fish and Game, the Department of Parks and Recreation, the State Water Resources Control Board and the regional Water Quality Control Boards to assist the State Forester in reviewing and deciding whether to approve timber harvesting plans under Section 4582.7 of the Public Resources Code.

Representatives of the departments and boards involved shall work under the direction of the Secretary of Resources or her designee with the objective of assisting the State Forester in his determination to accept or reject a timber harvest plan. They shall provide appropriate comments on values relating to sustained production of high-quality timber products as well as recreation, watershed, wildlife, range and forage, fisheries and aesthetic enjoyment, under Public Resources Code Section 4582.7, to implement the legislative intent stated in Public Resources Code Sections 4512-4513, and general environmental protection, under Public Resources Code Section 21000 (g).

Representatives of the departments and boards involved shall develop a streamlined process that will be the functional equivalent of the environmental impact report process, including opportunity for comment by the public, and expedited review of timber harvesting plans.
