EXECUTIVE ORDER B55-79

WHEREAS, Executive Order B-34-77 established a California Office of the Southwest Border States Commission; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order D-4-78 provided that the Office of the Governor shall have responsibility for administering the activities of the California Office of the Southwest Border States Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Governor may appoint an Alternate to represent California on the federal Southwest Border Regional Commission;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Edmund G. Brown Jr., Governor of the State of California, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by the Constitution and statutes of the State of California, do hereby issue this order to become effective immediately:

The Governor's Alternate to the federal Southwest Border Regional Commission shall also have responsibility for administering the activities of the California Office of the Southwest Border States Commission, including but not limited to authority over all matters relating to personnel and staffing.
