PROCLAMATION

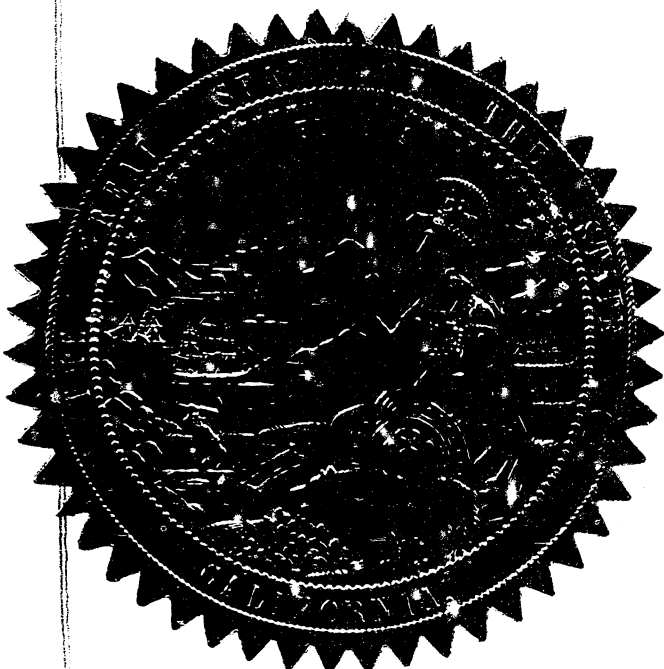
