EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. B-16-76

WHEREAS, Section 242, Title II of the federal Economic Opportunity Act of 1964, 42 USC Section 2843, gives the Governor the right to review proposed contracts, agreements, grants, loans, or other assistance provided pursuant to Title II of the Act; and

WHEREAS, Title 45 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Part 1075 authorizes the Governor, at his discretion, to designate the State Office of Economic Opportunity in the Employment Development Department to assist the Governor in carrying out the provisions of Section 242, Title II of the Act;

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me as Governor of the State of California;

IT IS ORDERED that the Director of the Employment Development Department is hereby authorized and directed to review all proposed contracts, agreements, grants, loans or other assistance provided pursuant to Title II, of the federal Economic Opportunity Act of 1964, and to take such action as he deems proper;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any action taken by the Director of the Employment Development Department pursuant to this Executive Order and the provisions of Section 242 of Title II of the federal Economic Opportunity Act of 1964, shall have the same force and effect as if taken by me.
