EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. B-29-77

WHEREAS, special funds are available to the State of California through Title II of the Public Works Employment Act of 1976 for the maintenance of basic services customarily provided to persons in the State; and

WHEREAS, the large majority of these services can be provided by employees obtained through the California civil service selection process; and

WHEREAS, under special and limited circumstances, appointments exempt from the civil service may be appropriate;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, EDMUND G. BROWN JR., Governor of the State of California, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by the Constitution and statutes of the State of California, do hereby issue this order to become effective immediately:

I

Effective March 1, 1977, the Employment Development Department shall have the authority and responsibility to coordinate and manage Title II of the Public Works Employment program. This authority and responsibility shall include but shall not be limited to the development and maintenance of necessary fiscal and programmatic management systems.

II

Individuals hired in Title II programs will normally be appointed through the civil service process.

III

Employees exempt from civil service may be appointed to Title II projects having staffing requirements which cannot reasonably be met through the civil service process.

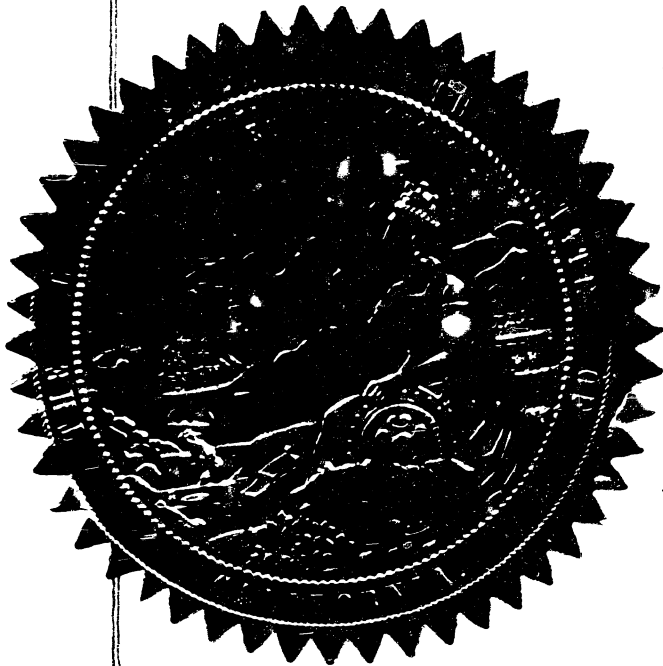

The Director of the Employment Development Department, with the concurrence of the Executive Officer of the State Personnel Board, is authorized to exercise the power to execute any necessary exempt appointment documents and the administration of the Oath of Office for the purpose of, and only to the extent necessary for the administration of Title II programs.
