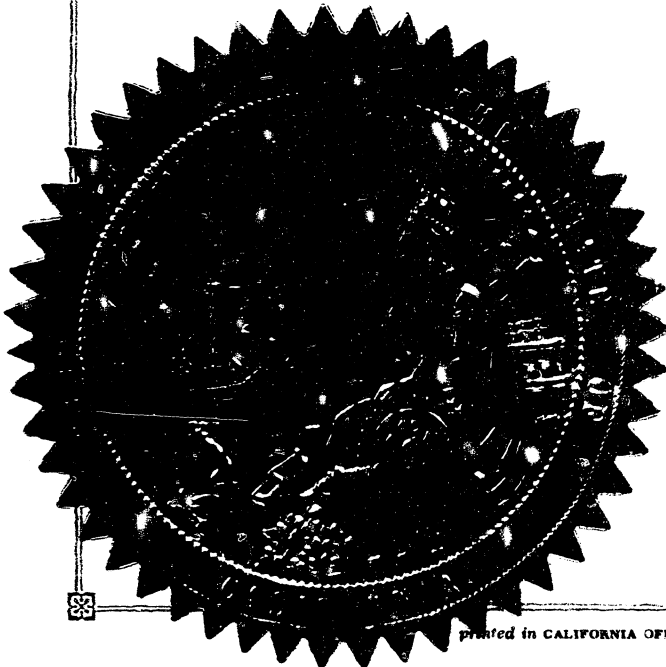
AMENDED PROCLAMATION
OF A
STATE OF EMERGENCY

I, Edmund G. Brown Jr., Governor of the State of California, have found that conditions of extreme peril to the agricultural industry and the safety of agricultural properties exist within the Counties of Alameda, San Mateo and Santa Clara. Beginning on or about June 17, 1980, and having grown progressively worse, the Mediterranean Fruit Fly (*Ceratitis capitata*) infestation, which by reason of its magnitude, is beyond the control of the services, personnel, equipment and facilities of said counties. Under the authority of Section 8625 of the Government Code, I therefore proclaim the existence of a State of Emergency and hereby implement the California Peacetime Emergency Plan in the Counties of Alameda, San Mateo and Santa Clara; and

Pursuant to this proclamation, I hereby direct all agencies of the state government to utilize and employ state personnel, equipment, and facilities for the performance of any and all activities to alleviate this emergency; and

Pursuant to Government Code Section 8571 and Public Resources Code Section 21080(b)(4) the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (Public Resources Code Sections 21000 et seq.) are suspended for the purpose of carrying out the activities authorized herein; and

In witness whereof, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of California to be affixed this 8th day of July, 1981.
