**AMENDMENTS TO REGULATIONS
FOR CALIFORNIA'S GASOLINE EMERGENCY**

Pursuant to the authority vested in me to promulgate, issue and enforce rules, regulations and orders, and in light of the "State of Emergency" which now exists as a result of a "sudden and serious shortage of gasoline, I hereby amend the Regulations for California's Gasoline Emergency, issued on November 14, 1979, as follows:

- 1. Amend second sentence of Rule 5(c) to read as follows:

Evidence of a commercial purpose may be demonstrated by possession of a business license or similar license.

- 2. Add Rule 11(e) to read as follows:

Vehicles operated by persons whose residence as shown on their drivers license is more than 100 miles distant from the place of purchase.

- 3. Amend Rule 18 to read as follows:

Rule 10 shall not take effect until seven (7) days after the date of proclamation of emergency for that county.

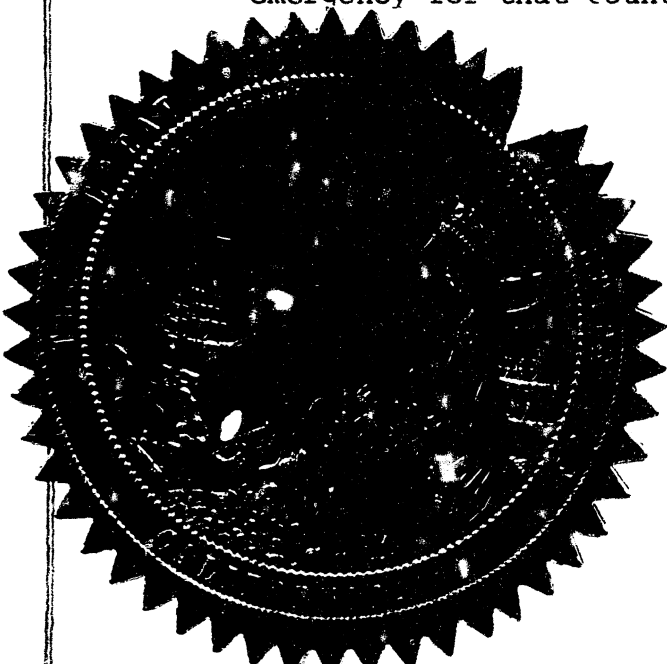
