PROCLAMATION  
OF A  
STATE OF EMERGENCY

I, EDMUND G. BROWN JR., Governor of the State of California, having found that conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property exist within the City of Laguna Beach, State of California, beginning on October 2, 1978, as a result of a landslide which, by reason of its magnitude, is beyond the control of the services, personnel, equipment and facilities of said city; and having been requested by the City Council, I proclaim a State of Emergency in the City of Laguna Beach.

I DIRECT that as soon hereafter as possible this proclamation be filed in the Office of the Secretary of State and that widespread publicity and notice be given to this proclamation.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of California to be affixed.
