PROCLAMATION  
OF A  
STATE OF EMERGENCY

I, EDMUND G. BROWN JR., Governor of the State of California, having been informed that conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property occurred within the Counties of San Bernardino and San Diego, State of California, beginning on September 10, 1976; that such conditions resulted from high winds, heavy rains, and flooding, and were beyond the control of the services, personnel, equipment and facilities of said Counties; and that the Boards of Supervisors of the Counties of San Bernardino and San Diego have requested this office to proclaim a State of Emergency in said Counties.

I therefore proclaim the existence of a State of Emergency and hereby implement the California Peacetime Emergency Plan in the Counties of San Bernardino and San Diego.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of California to be affixed this 22 day of September nineteen hundred and seventy-six.
