**MEDITERRANEAN FRUIT FLY**  
**EMERGENCY PROCLAMATION AMENDED ORDER NO. 2**

This amended order is based on the Amended Proclamation of A State of Emergency dated July 8, 1981 concerning the infestation of the Mediterranean fruit fly in the Counties of Alameda, Santa Clara and San Mateo, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof, and Government Code Section 8646 (d).

Mediterranean Fruit Fly Emergency Proclamation Order No. 2 is hereby amended by the addition of the following language thereto:

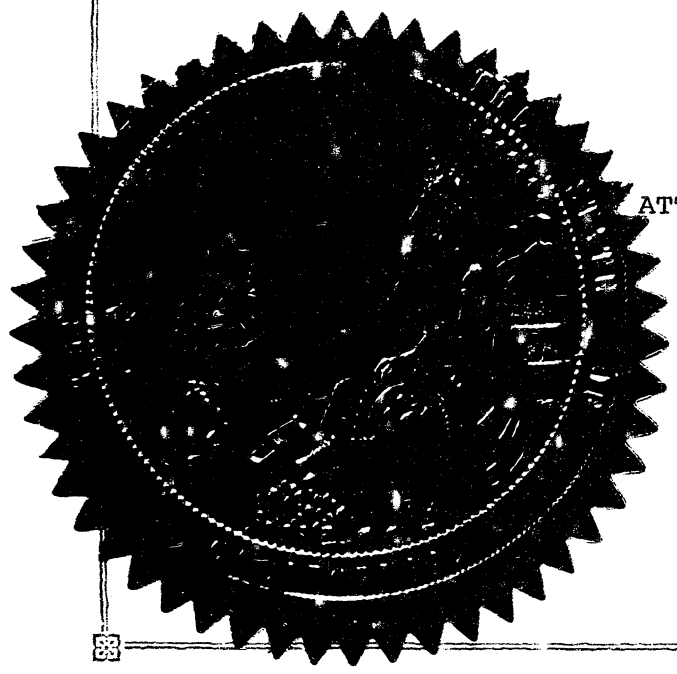
The following additional portion of San Mateo County within which the Mediterranean fruit fly is known to exist, is hereby proclaimed to be a quarantine area with respect to said pest:

That portion of San Mateo County beginning at the intersection of State Highway Route 92 and Interstate Route 280 northwest-erly along Interstate Route 280 to Crystal Springs Road, thence northeasterly along Crystal Springs Road to El Camino Real, thence southeasterly along El Camino Real to 3rd Avenue, thence north-easterly along 3rd Avenue to State Highway 101, thence southeast-erly along State Highway 101 to Ralston Avenue.

All persons residing within the quarantine area described above shall remove all Mediterranean fruit fly hosts from trees and plants located on their property by 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, July 30, 1981.
