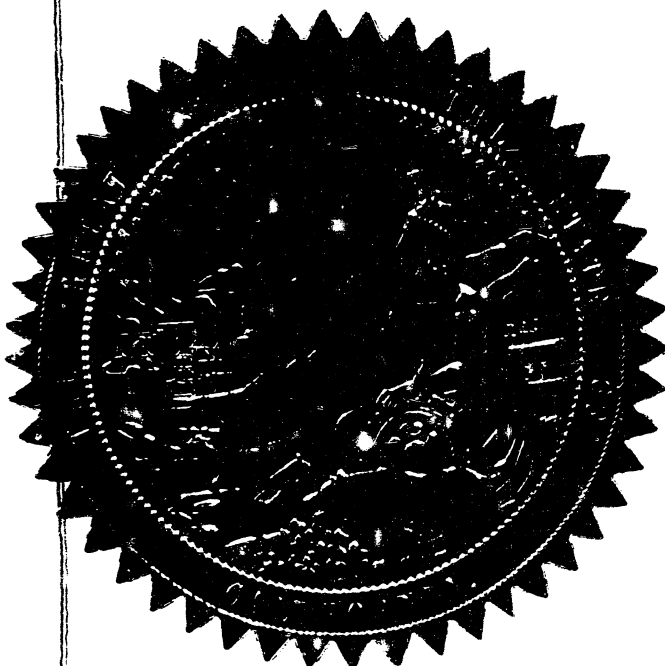

PROCLAMATION
OF A
STATE OF EMERGENCY

I, Edmund G. Brown Jr., Governor of the State of California, having been informed that a catastrophic failure, due to an earthquake, of a section of Route 101, six miles south of Eureka in the County of Humboldt, State of California, hereby proclaim the existence of a State of Emergency in the County of Humboldt, within the meaning of Section 125, Title 23, United States Code.
