WHEREAS, this organization has encouraged women to enter the motion picture industry and contribute their creative talent to this unique art form; and

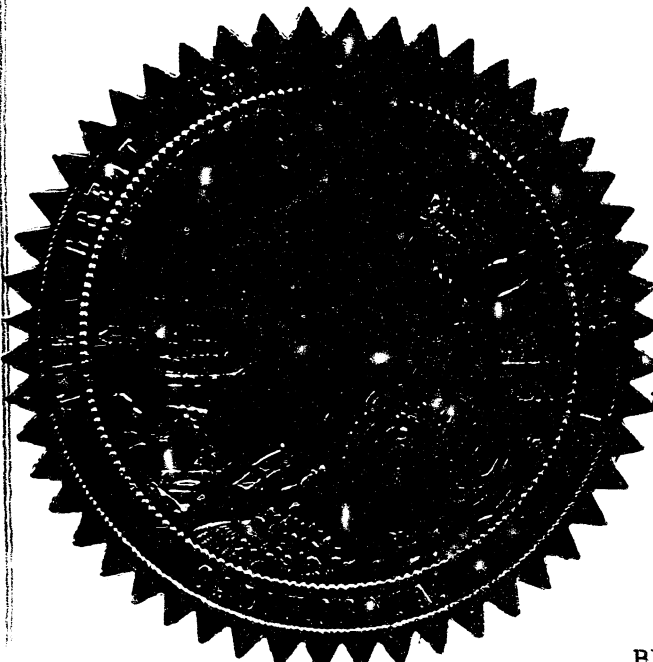
WHEREAS, the cinema, through a blending of art and technology has been a means for our country to reach out to the entire world as well as entertain and inspire our own citizens; and
