PROCLAMATION
OF A
STATE OF EMERGENCY

I, EDMUND G. BROWN JR., Governor of the State of California, having found that conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property exist within the County of Orange beginning on April 21, 1982, and continuing to the present as a result of strong winds and raging fire which, by reason of their magnitude, are exceeding the capabilities of the services, personnel, equipment and facilities of said county and having now been requested by the Board of Supervisors of said county, I, therefore, proclaim the existence of a State of Emergency and hereby implement the California Peacetime Emergency Plan in the County of Orange.

I DIRECT that as soon hereafter as possible, this proclamation be filed in the Office of the Secretary of State and that widespread publicity and notice be given to this proclamation.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of California to be affixed this 21st day of April, 1982.
