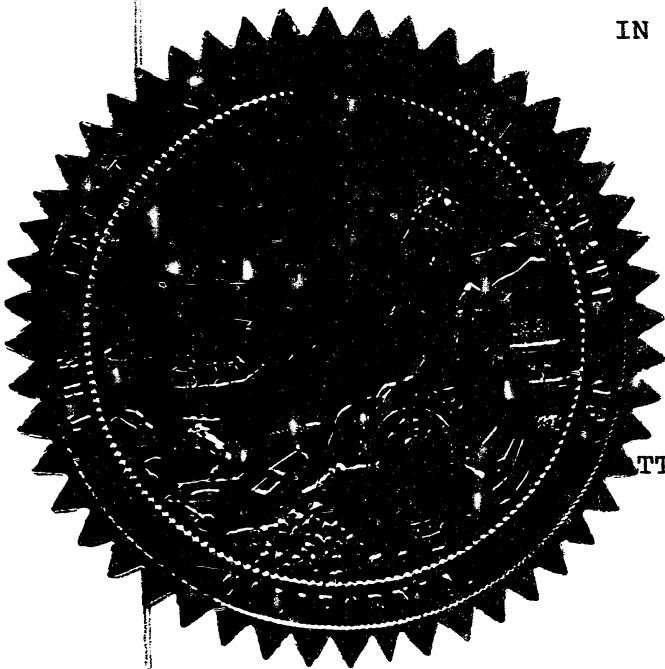
WHEREAS, Executive Order B-7-75, issued October 10, 1975, established the Office of Employee Relations within the Governor's Office to represent the Governor in all matters concerning State employee-employer relations; and

WHEREAS, effective May 1, 1981, the Governor's Reorganization Plan No. 1 of 1981 will establish the Department of Personnel Administration with central authority for personnel policies for all agencies and departments in the Executive Branch of State Government;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Edmund G. Brown Jr., Governor of the State of California, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by the Constitution and statutes of the State of California, do hereby issue this order to become effective immediately:

1. Executive Order No. B-7-75 is repealed as of May 1, 1981.
2. Effective May 1, 1981 the Office of Employee Relations is abolished and all authorities and responsibilities of the Office shall be vested in the Director of the Department of Personnel Administration.
