PROCLAMATION

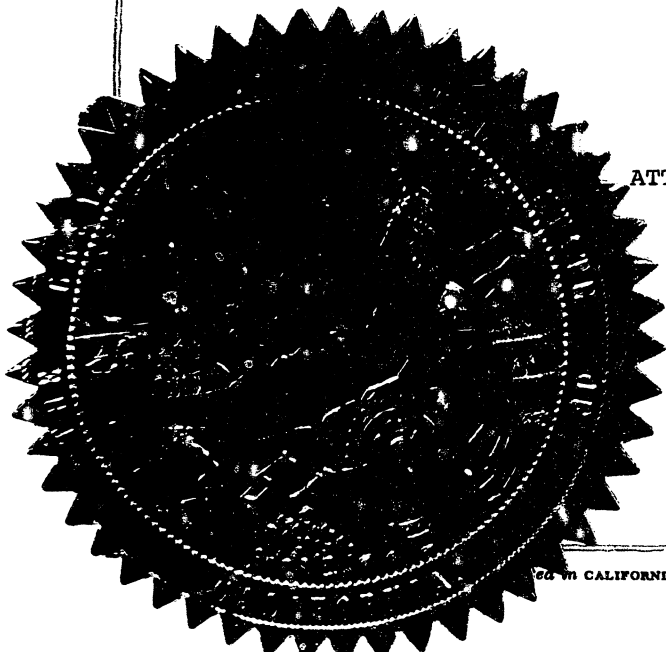
I, EDMUND G. BROWN JR., Governor of the State of California, having found conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property existed within the Counties of Monterey and Ventura of a sudden and serious gasoline shortage and having been requested by the Chairpersons of the Boards of Supervisors of said Counties, proclaimed the existence of a State of Emergency to exist in Ventura County on May 8, 1979 and in Monterey County on May 11, 1979.

Having now been advised by the Chairpersons of the Boards of Supervisors that the condition of extreme peril no longer exists within Monterey and Ventura Counties and at the request of the Boards of Supervisors, I therefore proclaim that the State of Emergency within Monterey and Ventura Counties no longer exists, effective as follows:

Monterey County - 0001 hours, October 1, 1979

Ventura County - 0001 hours, September 29, 1979
