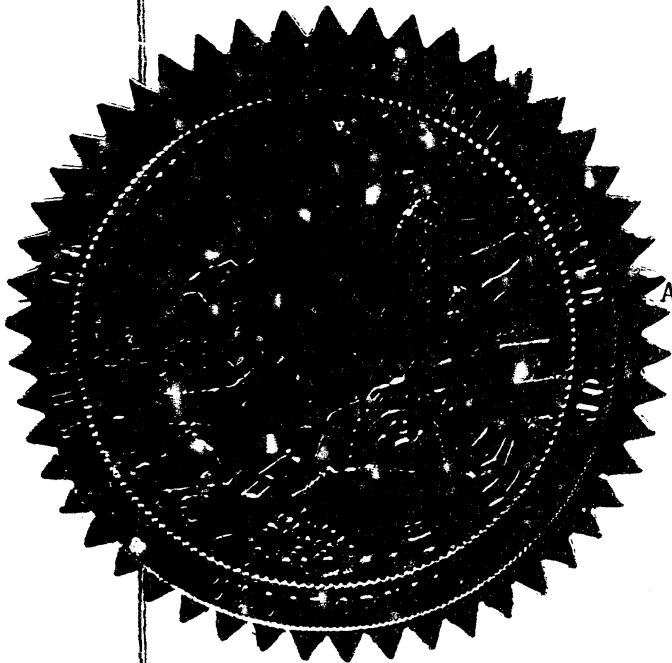

PROCLAMATION  
OF A  
STATE OF EMERGENCY

I, Edmund G. Brown Jr., Governor of the State of California, having been informed that a catastrophic failure of a section of Route 101, 4.36 miles north of Leggett in the County of Mendocino, State of California, hereby proclaim the existence of a State of Emergency in the County of Mendocino, within the meaning of Section 125, Title 23, United States Code.
