PROCLAMATION
OF A
STATE OF EMERGENCY

I, Edmund G. Brown Jr., Governor of the State of California, having been informed that beginning on or about February 5, 1978, high winds, heavy rains and flooding have caused serious damage to property, particularly highways, within the County of San Benito, State of California, hereby proclaim the existence of a State of Emergency in the County of San Benito, within the meaning of Section 125, Title 23, United States Code.
