PROCLAMATION

I, EDMUND G. BROWN JR., Governor of the State of California, having proclaimed that conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property prevailed in that portion of San Bernardino County as described in my Proclamation of a State of Emergency signed on the 8th day of May, 1979, as amended on the 7th day of June, 1979, do now find, at the request of the Board of Supervisors, it is necessary to further amend the Proclamation of a State of Emergency to exclude that portion of the County of San Bernardino lying east of Interstate Highway 15 where the State of Emergency no longer exists.

The new description of that area of San Bernardino County where the Proclamation of a State of Emergency remains in effect is that portion of the County bounded on the east by Interstate 15; on the north by the southern boundary of the San Bernardino National Forest; on the west by the Los Angeles County line; the southwest by the Orange County line; and the south by the Riverside County line.
