PROCLAMATION  
OF A  
STATE OF EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the laws of the State of California empower the Governor to proclaim a State of Emergency in an area or region of this State affected or likely to be affected by certain conditions of disaster or extreme peril to persons and property within the State, which proclamation shall be in writing and shall take effect immediately upon its issuance; and

WHEREAS, it is further provided by Section 2 (a) and (b) of Article XIII A of the Constitution, that after a disaster, as declared by the Governor, an assessment or reassessment may be made of taxable real property based on the County Assessor's evaluation of real property as shown on the 1975-76 tax bill when the fair market value of such real property as reconstructed is comparable to the fair market value prior to the disaster which occurred after the 1975 assessment.

WHEREAS, I, as Governor of the State of California, have found and so hereby find:

1. That conditions of disaster did arise and exist in the North Park area bounded by 3500 blocks of Felton; 3300 and 3400 blocks of Dwight; 3500 and 3600 blocks of Nile; and 3500 and 3600 blocks of Boundary, including 4127 1/2 Iowa Street, City of San Diego, County of San Diego, State of California, as a result of a mid-air crash which occurred on September 25, 1978.

2. That the Governor has been requested to proclaim a State of Emergency therein by the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego, and the City Council of the City of San Diego; and

3. That the aforesaid conditions of disaster warrant and necessitate the proclamation of the existence of a State of Emergency.

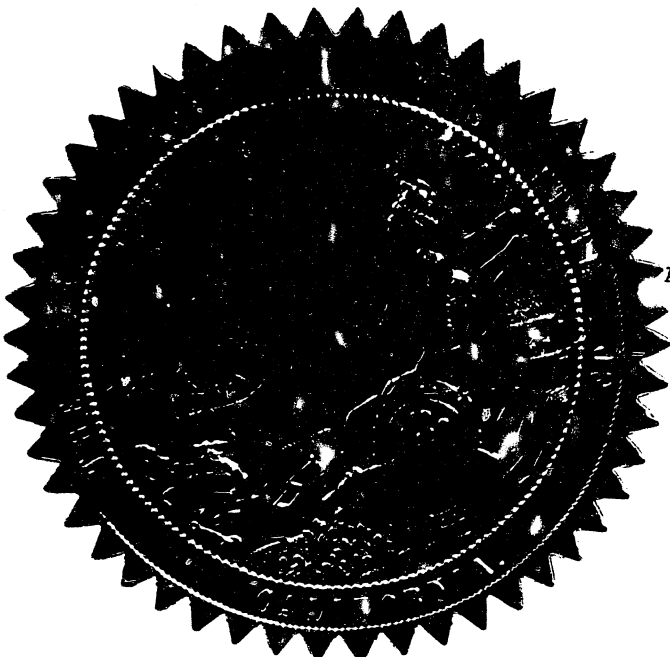
NOW, THEREFORE, I, EDMUND G. BROWN JR., Governor of the State of California, by virtue of the powers and authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of this State, do hereby proclaim the existence of a State of Emergency in the North Park area bounded by 3500 blocks of Felton; 3300 and 3400 blocks of Dwight; 3500 and 3600 blocks of Nile; and 3500 and 3600 blocks of Boundary, including 4127 1/2 Iowa Street, City of San Diego, County of San Diego, State of California, and


I DIRECT that this proclamation shall constitute the declaration of a disaster as referred to in Section 2 (a) and (b) of Article XIII A of the Constitution; and

I DIRECT that this proclamation shall take effect immediately, effective September 25, 1978, and that as soon hereafter as possible this proclamation be filed in the Office of the Secretary of State of the State of California; and that widespread publicity and notice be given to this proclamation.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of California to be affixed.


