WHEREAS, community-based primary care clinics for the delivery of preventative and acute health care have proven to be a successful approach to providing health services to people who otherwise would not be able to obtain them; and

WHEREAS, each year more than 1.3 million Californians receive sound health care services from primary care clinics in a cost-effective manner; and

WHEREAS, representatives from community health centers, community and free clinics, migrant health centers, rural health centers, women's clinics, Indian health clinics, community mental health centers, county sponsored primary care programs, public health clinics, and other community health organizations will convene in Sacramento June 3, 1982, in recognition of the progress made by these programs in the past 13 years; and

WHEREAS, the Alameda Health Consortium; Association of California Health Centers; Association of California Rural Health Centers, Inc.; Association of Free and Community Clinics of Los Angeles; California Association of Primary Care Clinics, Inc.; California Rural Health Federation, Inc.; California Union of Primary Care; California Urban Indian Council, Inc.; Coalition of Orange County Clinics; Northern California Association of Community Health Centers; San Diego Council of Community Clinics; and Western Association of Community Health Centers, Inc. have as their main objective the promotion and implementation of health plans and programs designed to improve the physical and emotional health and socio-economic conditions of communities served by these organizations;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Edmund G. Brown Jr., Governor of the State of California, do hereby proclaim June 3, 1982 as Community Health Day in California and commend these organizations for their community spirit, dedication, and interest in working towards making the availability of health care a reality for every Californian.
