PROCLAMATION

I, EDMUND G. BROWN JR., Governor of the State of California, having found conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property existed within the Counties of Marin, Orange and Sonoma as a result of a sudden and serious gasoline shortage and having been requested by the Chairpersons of the Board of Supervisors of said Counties, proclaimed the existence of a State of Emergency on May 8, 1979.

Having now been advised by the Chairpersons of the Board of Supervisors that the condition of extreme peril no longer exists within Marin, Orange, and Sonoma Counties and at the request of the Boards of Supervisors, I therefore proclaim that the State of Emergency within Marin, Orange and Sonoma Counties no longer exists, effective the 22nd day of September, 1979.
