PROCLAMATION

I, EDMUND G. BROWN JR., Governor of the State of California, having found conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property existed within the County of Los Angeles as a result of a sudden and serious gasoline shortage and having been requested by the Chairperson of the Board of Supervisor of said County, proclaimed the existence of a State of Emergency to exist in Los Angeles County on May 8, 1979.

Having now been advised by the Chairperson of the Board of Supervisors that the condition of extreme peril no longer exists within Los Angeles County and at the request of the Board of Supervisors, I therefore proclaim that the State of Emergency within Los Angeles County no longer exists, effective 0001 hours, November 3, 1979.
