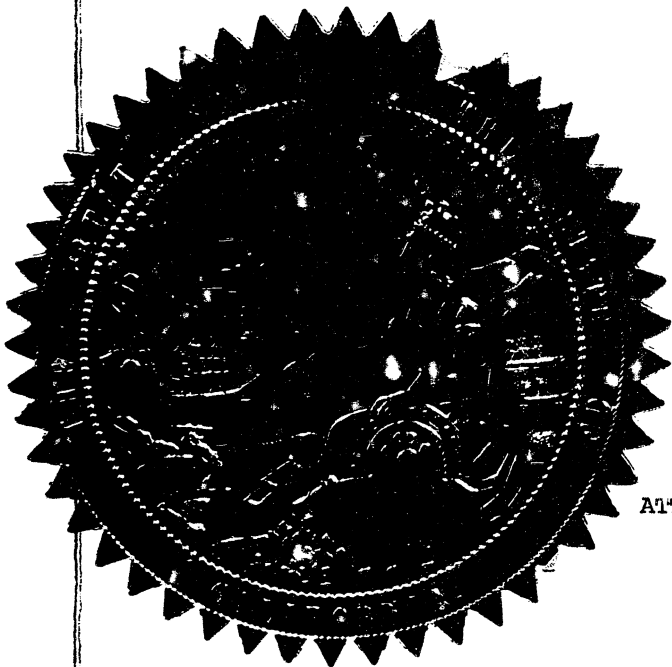

PROCLAMATION

I, EDMUND G. BROWN JR., Governor of the State of California, having found conditions of extreme peril no longer exist which threaten the safety of persons and property; and, further finding local authorities are now able to cope with the situation; therefore proclaim the State of Emergency previously proclaimed on the following dates and in the following jurisdictions no longer exists, effective immediately.

- July 26, 1977: County of Santa Barbara
- August 23, 1977: County of Imperial
- September 8, 1977: Counties of Monterey and Riverside
- December 21, 1977: City of Arvin
- December 21, 1977: County of Humboldt
- December 23, 1977: County of Kern
- January 10, 1978: County of San Diego
- January 20, 1978: County of Santa Cruz
- January 27, 1978: Counties of Humboldt and Mendocino
