WHEREAS, the health, safety and comfort of the people of California depends, in large part, on the ability of public works employees to perform their jobs with competence and efficiency; and

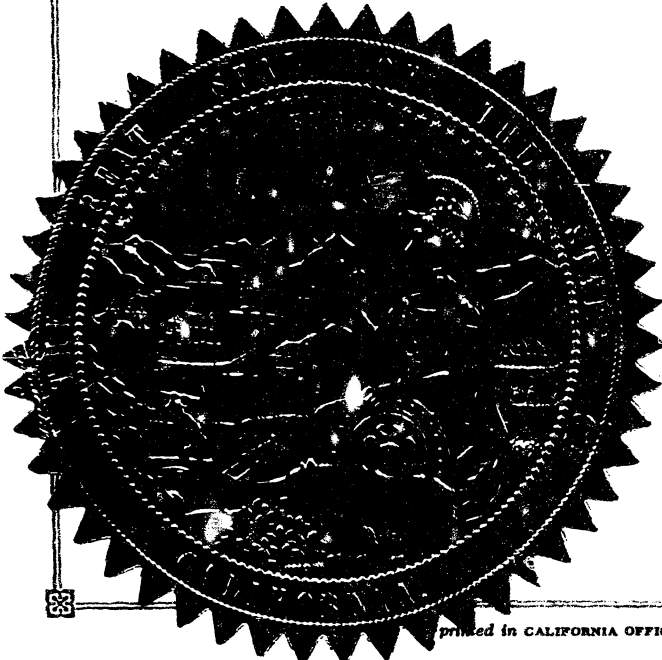
WHEREAS, public works officials also play an important role in the planning, design and construction of public facilities; and
