PROCLAMATION
OF A
STATE OF EMERGENCY

I, EDMUND G. BROWN JR., Governor of the State of California, having found that conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property caused by rain storms, flooding, mudslides, erosion, wind, and in the coastal areas, high waves, commencing in the Counties of Santa Cruz on February 8, 1980; Stanislaus on February 15, 1980; Solano on February 16, 1980; and Monterey on February 18; and continuing to present, which by reason of their magnitude are beyond the control of the services, personnel, equipment and facilities of affected Counties, and having been requested by the Chairpersons of the Boards of Supervisors, I proclaim a State of Emergency to exist in the Counties of:
