EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. B 12-75

WHEREAS, recently enacted legislation (Statutes of 1975, Chapter 1167) makes certain state employee members of the Public Employees' Retirement System eligible to receive additional service credit if the Governor determines that because of impending curtailment of, or changes in the manner of performing services, the best interests of the State would be served; and

WHEREAS, due to inflation, reduced revenues and other financial developments, a curtailment of services and changes in the manner of performing services by the Department of Rehabilitation is necessary and now underway;

WHEREAS, minimizing the number of demotions, mandatory transfers, and layoffs will also minimize the social and economic costs to employees and the State;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Edmund G. Brown Jr., Governor of the State of California, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by the Constitution and Statutes of the State of California, hereby specifically find and determine that the above-described curtailment of services and changes in the manner of performing services in the Department of Rehabilitation are now underway and will continue. In light thereof, the best interests of the State will be served by the granting of additional service credit pursuant to Section 20811 of the Government Code, to any state member of the Public Employees' Retirement System who retires from state employment in the Department of Rehabilitation on or after July 1, 1975, and before December 31, 1975, and without any intervening assignment in which he was a member of the Public Employees' Retirement System.
