SPECIAL ELECTION PROCLAMATION

I, EDMUND G. BROWN, Governor of California, do hereby proclaim and order that a special election shall be held on the fifteenth day of December, 1965, within the 26th Congressional District of the State, (as described by Chapter 1234 of the Statutes of 1961), to fill the vacancy in the office of Member of House of Representatives from said district resulting from the resignation of Congressman James Roosevelt.

AND I DO HEREBY offer a reward of one hundred dollars (\$100) for the arrest and conviction of any person who violates any of the provisions of Division 15 of the Elections Code; the rewards to be paid until the total amount hereafter expended for the purpose reaches the sum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000).
