EXECUTIVE ORDER

WHEREAS, a "Special Study Commission on Juvenile Delinquency" of five members was established by Executive Order of September 23, 1957, to assist the Board of Corrections in its studies, pursuant to Section 6027 of the Penal Code; and

WHEREAS, The Commission was instructed to render its final report by June 30, 1959, which will not allow sufficient time for study of all of the significant areas of juvenile delinquency which demand full examination; and

WHEREAS, The activities of the Commission have underscored the continuing need for intensive study of juvenile delinquency, and scope of the inquiries as outlined in the Executive Order of September 23, 1957, are endorsed; and

THEREFORE, Said Commission is now instructed to render its final report not later than June 30, 1960, in the manner provided by Section 6028.3 of the Penal Code.
