SPECIAL ELECTION PROCLAMATION

I, EDMUND G. BROWN, Governor of California, do hereby proclaim and order that a special election shall be held on the 7th day of April, 1959, within the Seventh Senatorial District of the State, comprising the Counties of Nevada, Placer, and Sierra, to fill the vacancy in the office of State Senator from said District resulting from the resignation of Senator Harold F. (Bizz) Johnson.

AND I DO HEREBY offer a reward of one hundred dollars for the arrest and conviction of any person who violates any of the provisions of Division XIV of the Elections Code; the rewards to be paid until the total amount hereafter expended for the purpose reaches the sum of ten thousand dollars.
