SPECIAL ELECTION PROCLAMATION

I, EDMUND G. BROWN, Governor of California, do hereby proclaim and order that a special election shall be held on the 3rd day of October, 1961, within the Thirty-third Senatorial District of the State, (as described by Chapter 397 of the Statutes of 1951), consisting of the County of Ventura, to fill the vacancy in the office of State Senator from said District resulting from the death of Senator James J. McBride.

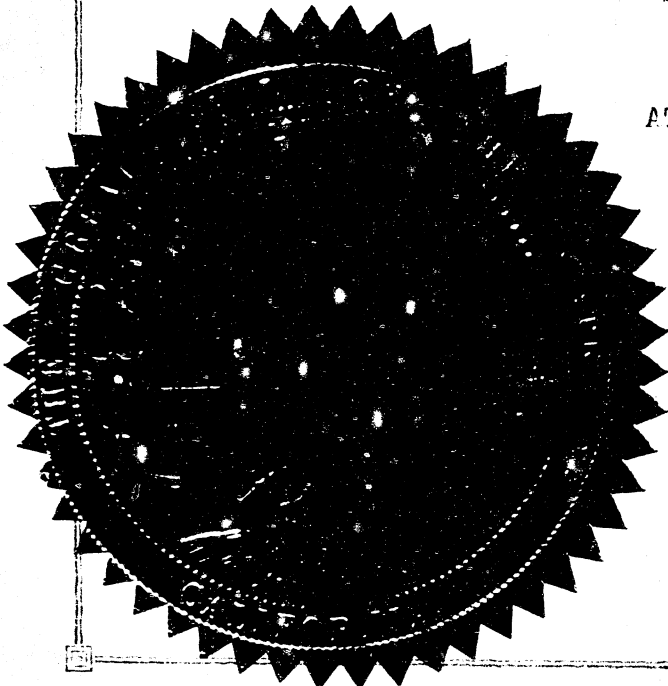
