PROCLAMATION

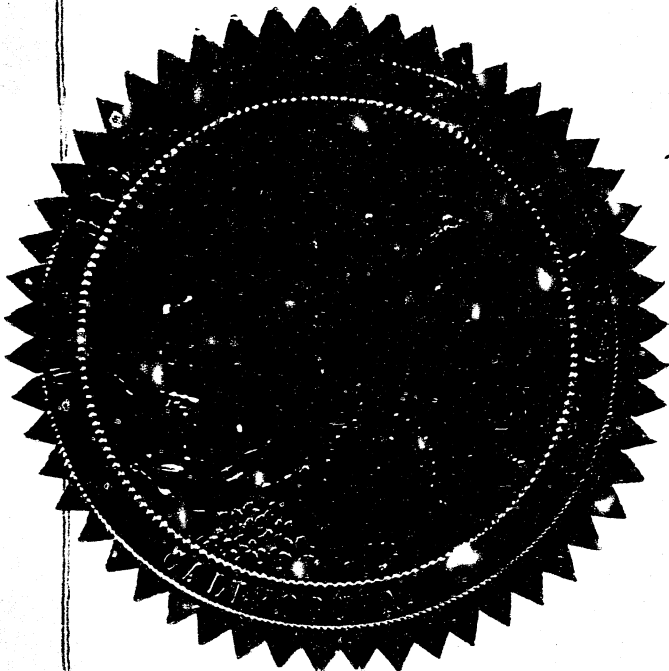
ACTIVATION OF THE NATIONAL GUARD

I, EDMUND G. BROWN, Governor of the State of California, am satisfied that a condition of tumult and riot exists in the County of *SAN FRANCISCO* and under the appropriate provisions of the Military and Veterans Code, I hereby order into the service of the State of California the California Army National Guard in such numbers as I shall subsequently determine necessary.

I DIRECT that this proclamation shall take effect immediately on this 27th day of *SEPTEMBER* and that as soon hereafter as possible this proclamation be filed in the office of the Secretary of State of the State of California; and that widespread publicity and notice be given to this proclamation.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of California to be affixed.
