PROCLAMATION

The President of the United States, Lyndon B. Johnson, having declared Monday, November 25, 1963, a day of national mourning for the untimely passing of John F. Kennedy, late President of the United States, I, Glenn M. Anderson, Acting Governor of the State of California, do hereby declare Monday, November 25, 1963, a day of mourning in memory of our late President to be observed consistent with Section 6700(n) of the Government Code and by all schools, colleges and universities, and I call upon all business and all citizens to join in the observance of this said occasion.
