PROCLAMATION
DECLARING THE TERMINATION
of the
STATE OF DISASTER

WHEREAS, on the 17th day of October, 1962, a State of Disaster was proclaimed to exist in the Counties of Alameda, Butte, Contra Costa, Modoc, Napa, San Mateo, Sierra, Sutter and Yuba, as a result of abnormally heavy and continuous rainfall and the acute threat of continuing storm and flood conditions, creating imminent danger to the lives, health and well-being of persons, the safety of public and private property, and the maintenance of essential services; and

WHEREAS, on October 25, 1962, a State of Disaster was proclaimed to exist in the County of Placer, and on October 30, 1962, a State of Disaster was proclaimed to exist in the County of Trinity, and on November 4, 1962, a State of Disaster was proclaimed to exist in the County of Lassen, all as a result of the same storm; and

WHEREAS, the conditions warranting and necessitating the proclamation of such State of Disaster are now deemed not to be beyond the control of the normal protective services, personnel, equipment and facilities of the public agencies and political subdivisions of those counties;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, EDMUND G. BROWN, Governor of the State of California, by virtue of the powers and authority vested in me

by the Constitution and laws of this State, do hereby proclaim the termination of said State of Disaster; and


I DIRECT that this proclamation shall take effect immediately and shall, as soon hereafter as possible, be filed in the Office of the Secretary of State of the State of California.
