



SPECIAL ELECTION PROCLAMATION


I, EDMUND G. BROWN, Governor of California, do hereby proclaim and order that a special election shall be held on the 3rd day of December, 1963, within the 7th Senatorial District (Placer, Nevada and Sierra Counties) of the State, (as described by Chapter 1234 of the Statutes of 1961), to fill the vacancy in the office of State Senator of said district resulting from the resignation of Senator Ronald G. Cameron.

AND I DO HEREBY offer a reward of one hundred dollars (\$100) for the arrest and conviction of any person who violates any of the provisions of Division 15 of the Elections Code; the rewards to be paid until the total amount hereafter expended for the purpose reaches the sum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000).
