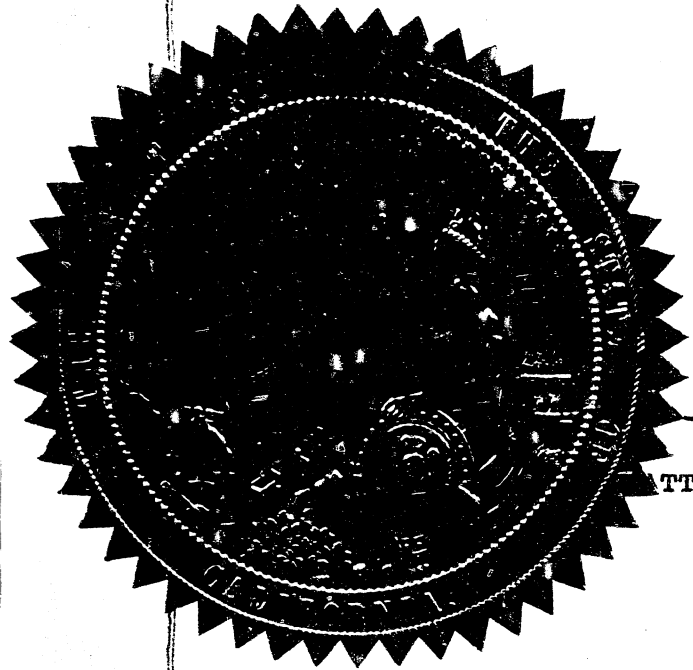
WHEREAS all of us are proud of their leadership in many fields of endeavor, and their acceptance of "the responsibility of full partnership."
