EXECUTIVE ORDER

WHEREAS, THE SPECIAL COMMISSION ON PROBLEMS OF INSANITY RELATING TO CRIMINAL OFFENDERS -- PROCEDURAL was created by Executive Order dated May 4, 1960, pursuant to Section 6027 et seq., of the Penal Code; and

WHEREAS, the Commission, in its first Interim Report submitted to me and to the Legislature, has indicated that it has made great progress in the study of problems of insanity but by reason of the scope of its mission will be unable to complete such studies within the period heretofore established for its final report, to wit, June 30, 1961, and it is necessary that further time be provided;

NOW, THEREFORE, The Special Commission on Problems of Insanity Relating to Criminal Offenders -- Procedural is hereby continued and instructed to present its final report and recommendations not later than June 30, 1962, in the manner prescribed by Section 6028.3 of the Penal Code.
