AUTHORIZATION FOR TRANSFER OF MONEYS
SECTION 16310, GOVERNMENT CODE

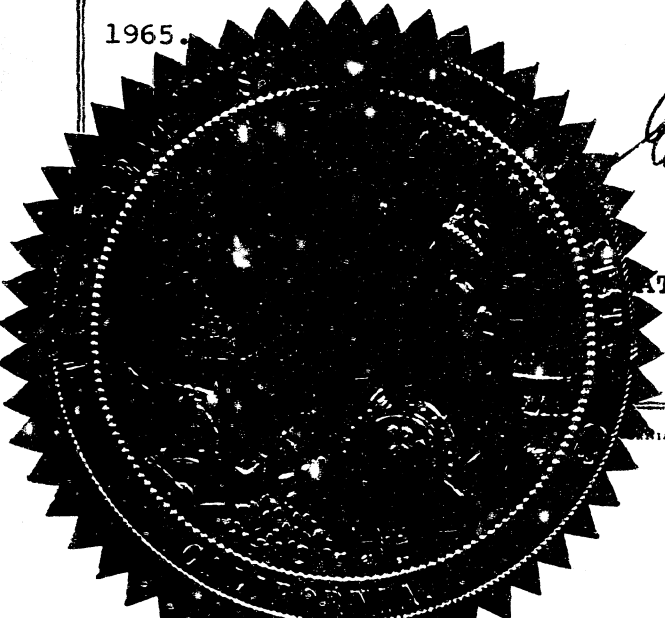
WHEREAS, the State Controller has reported that cash in the General Fund will be exhausted on or about February 24, 1965, and that there is money in the Motor Vehicle Fund and in the Special Deposit Fund (Motor Vehicle Department--Uncleared Collections Account) not required to meet any demands which have accrued or may accrue against such funds; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that, pursuant to Section 16310 of the Government Code, moneys may be transferred from such funds to the General Fund; and

WHEREAS, it is understood that any moneys so transferred under the authority of this authorization shall be returned to the respective funds as soon as there is sufficient money in the General Fund;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Governor hereby orders that the Controller transfer not to exceed \$60,000,000 or so much thereof as may be needed from time to time during the balance of the 1964-65 fiscal year, from said funds to the General Fund under Section 16310 of the Government Code.
