WHEREAS, current operational concepts in civil defense and disaster preparedness, developed in the light of new techniques, have necessitated changes in established plans; and

WHEREAS, the publication and promulgation of a revised California Civil Defense and Disaster Plan, effective January 1, 1964, supersedes and rescinds the California Civil Defense Operations Plan (CALOP-I), dated March 1, 1959;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, EDMUND G. BROWN, Governor of the State of California, by virtue of the powers and authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of this State and in accordance with the provisions of Section 1540 of the Military and Veterans Code, do hereby issue this Order, to become effective on January 1, 1964, amending Executive Order No. 60-CD-1 to reflect the above-stated changes, as follows:

1. In Paragraph A-1, delete the words "California Civil Defense Operations Plan (CALOP-I)" and substitute the words "California Civil Defense and Disaster Plan";
2. In Paragraph A-2, delete the words "Danger Zones" and substitute the words "Potential Targets"; and delete the words "California Civil Defense Operations Plan (CALOP-I)" and substitute the words "California Civil Defense and Disaster Plan";



3. In Paragraph A-3-a, delete the words "Danger Zone" and substitute the words "Potential Target"; strike out the words "at a site in the support area, or"; and delete the words "possible target" and substitute the words "Potential Point Target".

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, as amended, Executive Order No. 60-CD-1 remains in full force and effect.




