EXECUTIVE ORDER 66-4

Authorizing Disclosure of Information from Sales Tax Files to Department of Professional and Vocational Standards.

By virtue of the authority vested in me as Governor of the State of California, and upon consideration of the request of Harold J. Powers, Director, Department of Professional and Vocational Standards, for authorization to examine sales and use tax records for the purpose of checking the nature of the business operations of persons holding seller's permits under the Sales and Use Tax Law, upon recommendation of the Board of Equalization and good cause appearing, I hereby authorize the Board of Equalization under Section 7056 of the Revenue and Taxation Code to allow any authorized representative of the Bureau of Electronic Repair Registration of the Department of Professional and Vocational Standards to examine the files of the State Board of Equalization for the sole purpose of checking the nature of the activities of holders of seller's permits, as described on their applications for permits, to aid the department in ascertaining whether the permit holder is engaged in the business of repairing within the meaning of Section 9801(g) of the Business and Professions Code.
